Brightly colored, fun fleece blankets are a blessing for the children and the parents of those who are hospitalized. A simple blanket can provide comfort and reassurance to a sick child no matter what age. Join us any time – it's not a structured activity.

The blankets we make require NO sewing knowledge or ability!

Here's what you need for the different blanket sizes:

Preemie blankets

1 yard of 45" wide fleece makes 2 blankets

Newborn blankets

1 yard of 60" wide fleece makes 2 blankets

Toddler blanket

1 yard of 45" wide fleece

School Age blanket

1 1/8 of 60" wide fleece

Teen blanket

1 ¼ to 1 ½ yards of 60" wide fleece

The fleece can be bought at Joann's – watch for sales. Also, check out the remnants section for some great buys as well; just be sure to check the size of the remnant. Can't get out to shop?
